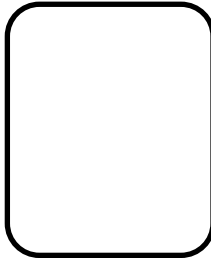

Welcome To The 150th Annual ILLINOIS STATE SHOOT



CLASSIFICATION WILL OPEN MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2026, AT 9:00 a.m.

ALL SHOOTERS must have a complete list of their target scores and averages up to date. If not up to date, shooter may be classified at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

Any shooter with less than a total of 500 16-yard targets for the current shoot year shall shoot no less than Class B. Any

shooter who has shot less than 300 doubles targets for the current year shall shoot no less than Class B.

Any shooter who has shot less than 500 handicap targets for the current year shall shoot penalty yardage.

PENALTY YARDAGE WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: YOUR CURRENT ATA ASSIGNED YARDAGE PLUS A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YARDS TO A MAXIMUM OF 25 YARDS.

Penalty yardage will be waived for Senior Veterans.

It shall be the shooter's responsibility to shoot the assigned yardage.

ALL TARGET requirements are based from September 1, 2025, and must be on your current card.

All class winners and ties, resident and non-resident, must report to Handicap Committee for reclassification prior to the next day's event. It is the shooters responsibility to shoot the correct classification or yardage.

Starting Wednesday all winners and ties move up a class.

I.R.S. regulations require a Social Security number before accumulated event winnings of over \$600 can be distributed.

Classification Committee personnel will be able to directly input Social Security numbers at the time of classification.

If you anticipate receiving option checks through the mail, it will be necessary to report your Social Security number at the time of classification.

The Classification Committee reserves the right to reclassify or disqualify any shooter at any time.

An error at the handicap table does not relieve shooter of the responsibility of knowing the rules and shooting in the proper class and at the proper yardage.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES

It is the responsibility of the shooters to make sure that all special categories (Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, and Elder) are declared at the time of classification in any tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter.

Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error.

The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category:

At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-Jr., Jr., Jr. Gold, Sub-Vet., Vet., Sr. Vet)

- Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule •

1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th birthday, may declare Lady 1
2. A female shooter, who has reached her 55th birthday, may declare Lady 2
3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday may declare Sub-Junior
4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday may declare as Junior
5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday may declare as Junior Gold
6. A shooter who is 55 but has not reached his/her 65th birthday may declare as Sub Veteran
7. A shooter who is 65 but has not reached his/her 70th birthday may declare as Veteran
8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran
9. A shooter who is 75 years of age and older may declare as an Elder for events 12, 13 & 14. Elder category shooters are eligible for Sr. Veteran trophy. There must be 5 entries in a special category before a trophy is awarded.

SENIOR VETERANS ONLY ARE EXEMPT FROM TARGET REQUIREMENTS!

GENERAL INFORMATION

ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the Illinois State Trapshooters Association will be held Friday night, June 19, 2026, following shoot-offs. At this meeting, nominations for ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate will be accepted. The election will follow after nominations have been closed. To vote in this election, you must be in possession of a 2026 ATA card and a 2026 ISTA membership and meet the eligibility requirements as defined by the ATA.

STARTING TIME

PLEASE NOTE: Each day's program will start promptly at the time specified. YOU MUST BE READY TO SHOOT WHEN YOUR SQUAD IS POSTED OR CALLED. Any shooter missing his/her squad will be resquaded at the end of the program after paying a resquading fee of \$10.00. Check your squad number and please be ready.

PRESQUADDING

You will be able to presquad for the IL State Shoot using www.presquad.com, beginning April 15th at noon and closing at noon on June 11th. The non-refundable fee is \$2 per post (\$10 per squad). Fees can be paid using your credit card or a check can be made out to Brittany Shooting Park and mailed to Michelle Mueller, 7933 Whitefield Road, Shipman, IL 62685 within 10 days of presquadding. Mail-in presquadding will not be accepted.

ATA RULES WILL GOVERN THIS TOURNAMENT

The management (Directors) reserve the right to refuse any entry without explanation or cause the withdrawal of any shooter who may, in their opinion, be interfering with the harmony of the shoot. The management also reserves the right to cancel, change, or step up the program in case of inclement weather. A shooter may be disqualified for an event or for the whole tournament at any time by shoot management, who is under the obvious influence of alcohol or drugs before starting or during any event, sub-event, shoot-off or practice.

TRAPS AND TARGETS

Automatic Pat Traps will be used on all Fields. White Flyer Orange Dome targets will be thrown. Targets will be set each morning. Only authorized ISTA Personnel may reset targets. Any unauthorized person observed resetting targets may be disqualified from that event.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Anyone breaking 100 or 200 straight in Singles at the Illinois State Shoot, providing they have not won one previously, will be awarded a State Pin. State Pins will also be awarded for Handicap and Doubles on 100 straight scores. All Doubles will be shot 25 pair on a trap in all doubles events. 50 targets will be shot on each field in all single and handicap event.

PLEASE TAKE 50 SHELLS TO THE LINE

The shoot management reserves the right to shoot 10 per post or 100 per trap should the need arise. Officers and Directors of the Illinois State Trapshooter Association will make all decisions as to the interpretation of rules. The Directors decisions are final.

ALL ISTA DIRECTORS ARE OFFICIAL LINE REFEREES

Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times by all shooters, workers and anyone on the firing line. (No exceptions)

ENTRIES

Any shooter withdrawing from any event may not re-enter that event! Options may be added prior to the start of the event. No entry fee refunded, including options and purses, unless shoot is canceled. Entries for events other than the current days shooting will be accepted after 1:00 p.m. The entry desk and cashier windows will close daily at 4:00 p.m. Checks will be accepted for the amount of entry only. No refunds will be allowed. Credit cards are accepted with a 3% fee.

WE WILL NOT CALL SQUAD NUMBERS ON THE PA SYSTEM

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than two (2) sub-events on the practice trap. Shooters will NOT be allowed to make up sub-events on program traps.

Note: If you are unable to join your squad before they have started their third sub-event, you must be resquaded and pay a \$10.00 resquadding fee. If you miss two sub-events, you must report immediately after completing last sub-event, to the ISTA classification office to make up any targets on the practice trap.

TROPHIES

No shooter may win more than one trophy in the same event.

All trophies, ISTA and ATA will be awarded according to ATA rules and procedures.

Lady 1, Lady 2, Junior Gold, Junior, Sub-Junior, Sub-Veteran, Veteran and Sr. Veteran trophies will be decided on all 200 targets of 200 target events. All trophies must be picked up before the conclusion of the 2026 state shoot.

Trophy pick up times will be posted daily at the trophy pick up table and the classification building

NO TROPHIES WILL BE SHIPPED!

The ISTA will not be responsible for any trophy left more than 30 days of the conclusion of the 2026 State Shoot.

Added money in all events will be awarded with trophy.

SHOOT-OFFS

Officers of the State Association or their delegates will be in charge of all shoot-offs.

Any shooter not answering the call, will forfeit the shoot-off. Shoot-offs will be under the lights if necessary.

All shoot-offs will be shot to conclusion. Other trophies may be carried over at the discretion of the Directors.

OPTIONS

All purses will be paid out as printed in event description. All results are final 1 hour after completion of event.

Payouts available the next day after 1:00 pm.

CAMPERS & VENDORS

Camping spots with water and electric hook-ups are limited to 160. Camping rates are \$195 for the state shoot week (Monday, June 15, through Sunday, June 21, 2026). Additional nights are \$30 per night. We will use your spots for AIM camping the previous weekend unless we know you are coming early. AIM camping is \$30 per night.

Reservations are to be made with Michelle Mueller, (618) 292-8880, with a deposit payable to Brittany Shooting Park, 11374 Prairie Dell Road, Bunker Hill, IL 62014. Reservations from last year will carry over until April 1, 2026.

Confirmation/payment must be received by April 1, 2026, or campsite will be given to campers on waiting list.

ALL VEHICLES - GOLF CART - ATV RULES

All carts/ATVs must stay behind the sidewalk.

No one may operate a cart/ATV or any vehicle unless they possess a valid driver's license.

PLEASE OBSERVE 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON THE GROUND

Operators must show proof of adequate insurance on privately owned carts or ATVs and a valid drivers license. A copy of insurance is required to rent or use personal carts on the grounds of BSP.

Anyone wishing to rent a golf cart needs to contact Midwest Golf Cart & Equipment Company at (618) 797-2278 by May 15th to arrange a rental & delivery to Brittany Shooting Park. Neither ISTA or BSP will have extra carts to rent.

PETS

All pets must be on a leash at all times while on the grounds. Pets will not be allowed in any building at any time.

Pet owners are required to pick up and dispose of their pet's waste.

PRACTICE

Practice will be available on the grounds.

ATTENDANCE PINS

Illinois State Attendance Pins will be awarded. Get your pin when you get classified.

One pin awarded to each shooter. Additional pins may be purchased for \$2.00 on Sunday.

SHELLS

There will be a supply of shells available on the grounds at reasonable prices. No other shell sales will be allowed on the ground. Reloads may be used that conform to ATA standards.

SHELL PICK-UP

Shell pick-up will not be allowed during any part of this program!

The shooting begins with the shooter on the far-left end of the line. The first shooter calls for a target and must shoot the target on the rise. If they hit the target, the next shooter to their right will call for a target. If the first shooter misses their target, the second shooter must shoot at it. If they hit the target, the first shooter is out. If the second shooter misses the target, the third shooter can shoot at it. If they hit the target, the first and second shooters are out. If they miss it, all shooters are safe, and the second shooter will start the next round. This sequence is repeated down the line.

When the next-to-last shooter is first, it makes the person on the far left the third shooter. The rotation will continue until there is only one shooter left. A shooter who shoots out of turn or at a target that has been hit will be out.
